

## Catwalkers Basic getting started guide.

Once the CD has been installed - you are now ready to enjoy making your first Catwalker.

- a) The screen opens with a Fashion Walk
- b) All the characters line up for your attention on the bottom of your screen - pass your mouse over the images to see which one you want - as you move your mouse left or right the characters move until you click on the one you want
- c) the selected character responds with an appropriate sound and walks down the catwalk for your delight - you are asked if you would like this character - you respond either yes or no - if you choose no - it returns to the bottom of your screen for you to choose another one.
- d) if you say yes - your chosen character walks off and then appears on your colouring in screen as a line drawing.
- e) At the top left hand side of the screen a little picture called a 'screen grab' appears also - this is to give you an example of how to colour in and also you can print it off at the end of your project as a 'put together' guide in other words it shows you where the pieces go.
- f) You are now ready to colour in using the few simple buttons on the right hand side.

Choose the top button - this gives you a colour palette - point your cursor at any part of the palette you wish and the colour then appears in a grid on your colouring-in page for you to use when you are ready to start colouring.

Continue selecting colours until you are happy with your selection (black lives at the top right hand corner)

Next choose the second button - in here you will find patterns for the cloths , colours for fur etc and a selection of 'eyes'. If you require white (obviously it is impossible to print white on white - you would not see it - so choose something like a white cloud pattern ) When you have enough patterns selected return to your colouring-in page.

g) On your colouring grid whichever square has a yellow square around it denotes it to be the active colour -Now have fun - just point at a section on the character and click - you will see the selected pattern flood into the section and colour it. Go back to your grid click on another colour or pattern and continue until all of your creature is coloured in.

H) Once you have completely coloured your character in (please note that any section left white will not print) - say print: You will be asked Do you want a screen grab? - say yes.

Your printer will now print off 3 sheets - one will be the screen grab

One will be the body parts that are not on the embossing board and one will be your catwalk character coloured in sheet.

i) Take your coloured in character sheet and fold in half on the edge of the printing as indicated. Now take your Keepsake Dress to Impress Embossing Board (which you need to complete the project) depending on which character you have chosen (some characters use the romper suit and some use the evening dress.)

j) Open up the printed sheet and place over the design keeping the fold to the right hand side (after lubricating the wrong side of your design with a dry tumble dry sheet - to make the ball tool move more easily) proceed now to emboss the design using the patented lead-in channels. Once embossed - cut out your design and put to one side.

k) Next cut out the other sheet of all the other body parts

l) Next choose a matching piece of A4 matching card - fold in half , keep the fold on the right hand side and emboss the character again -this becomes your base card - cut out the design.

m) You can now mount your catwalk cloths over the base card and attach the head, eyes etc - paws and feet and any other embellishments of your choice - using the screen grab picture as a guide.

Now stand back and enjoy your creation.
